

## **REVE – Concept for the project evaluation**

### ***Aims and ways of evaluation***

The evaluation process has to support the efficient implementation during the whole lifecycle of the project. The evaluation will include contribution to the:

- Formal project evaluation - that has to be done for the project report by the project co-ordinator by
  - listing concrete achievements
  - presentable outputs
  - meeting the formal requirements of the contract
  
- A more “investigative” evaluation – continuous in-depth examination of the project implementation
  - from different angles than the formative one,
  - as a dynamic system,
  - in the changing environment
  - considering wider context of project implementation

### ***The investigative evaluation***

It will include the following elements:

- Follow-up of the primary concept, ‘philosophy’ of the project and its realisation during the implementation
- Survey about the development of the policy and social environment, their influence on the project’s aims
- Following the change/development of relevance of the project’s goals during the implementation period
- Synergy with other similar EU initiatives?

### ***Dynamic approach - the interaction context***

- Survey and analysis of (formal or informal) feedbacks experienced during the project implementation from actors in the field

### ***Innovative elements***

- Inventory of the new aspects, approaches, tasks, ideas emerged during the realisation – in comparison with the initially used ones

***Internal investigation of implementation - project management***

- Internal investigation of the project implementation:
  - partnerships within the consortium,
  - synergie - added value of co-operation vs. separative division of labour
  - wide consortium - partners potentially representing complementary competencies: is that being used in a systematic and efficient way?
  - tasks and resources – are they proportional?
  - SWOT of the project – collecting and comparing all partners' opinion

***Investigation and exploitation of the potential of the project***

- Approach systematically and efficiently the accumulated information and experience
- Continuous co-operation with the Commission to present achievements and highlight emerging potential of the project
- “Communication interface” towards clients, partners, users of project outcomes

***Looking forwards***

- Proposals for future actions, continuation, deployment of the project
